COURSE PREREQUISITES

BISC 305 and 329¹

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The course provides practical and theoretical instruction in organ and tissue level animal physiology. The laboratory exercises complement and expand upon concepts presented in animal physiology lecture (BISC 305) and they allow the student to explore specific subjects to a greater depth in a problem-oriented fashion.

REQUIRED TEXTBOOK(S)

Laboratory outlines will explain what you have to do. Some preparation before class will be required. You will also need to do some reading and library research to answer some of the questions posed in the lab exercises.

MARK DISTRIBUTION

You will be assigned to write up 3 of the course's eight laboratory exercises. Each formal write-up will contribute 25% of your overall grade. Each of the remaining five exercises will be assessed with a quiz that contributes 5% of your final grade.
