**Tough Fishing! DDT and the Atlantic salmon as reported in the angling literature of the day.**

(Oral, Regular presentation – English)

Not surprisingly, people closely associated with the Atlantic salmon sport fishery were among the first to notice the effects of widespread DDT spray programs implemented to control the eastern spruce budworm, *Choristoneura fumiferana*, [Lepidoptera: Tortricidae] in the 1950's. In a totally non-scientific analyses, the impressions and concerns of anglers, written at the time, will be discussed in the context of this large-scale pest control initiative.
