GF = **Graduate Fellowship**, a one-term award normally valued at \$6,500; to be eligible to hold a GF, the applicant must be registered as a full-time, regular (not "on-leave" or "part-time") student and must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.50.

GIRTA = **Graduate International Research Travel Award**, provides support to Master's and PhD students who must travel in order to undertake research for their degree requirements; award is valued to a maximum of \$6,500 and is tenable only in the term in which the travel is occurring.

TMRA = **Travel and Minor Research Awards** are primarily intended to support the travel component of the scholarly activity of graduate students related to their research, most often for conference attendance; typical value is \$500 which must be matched by funding from the Senior Supervisor.

**President's PhD Scholarship (PS)** rewards PhD students who have made excellent progress in their degree, and who have demonstrated <u>academic excellence</u>, <u>substantial scholarly output and leadership early in their PhD program relative to their peers</u>; typical value \$6500.
