- a) Out-of-date statements regarding the SFSS have been replaced with appropriate references to the GSS

Lines 72-75: The three Events Committee Officers are included in the list of elected caucus officers

Lines 93-95: The duties of the three Events Committee Officers are "To share and distribute the events committee duties outlined by Article VI"

Lines 112-119: Definition of the Events committee: "The caucus shall have an Events Committee consisting of three officers who will share duties in a fair and equitable manner. The powers and duties of the events committee are limited to the following:

- 1) To assist one another in organizing and co-coordinating caucus events under the guidance and assistance of the Chair and Associate Chair;
- 2) To recruit and direct caucus volunteers who will assist with running these events

- c) Amendment of Chair and Associate Chair's duties to reflect creation of the Events Committee

i. Lines 83-84, and 90

Lines 83-85: "To oversee and co-coordinate the events organized by the Events Committee"
