- 1. Welcome -- Meeting called to order at 15:02 by Dan Greenberg.
 - a. Attendance

Quick round of introductions of all present members.

- b. Additions to Agenda
 - i. BISC logo contest update

Still only one submission for the logo contest. Dan Greenberg spoke with Elizabeth Elle (Department Chair), who is very supportive of the initiative. Plan is to start the contest again in mid-late August when people are back on campus, and run through falls semester so the merchandise would be ready for the Christmas party. Contest, production, and distribution/sale will be run by caucus, and profits will return to caucus.

Idea is to form a small committee to run contest, and figure out logistics (how to produce items, manage orders, payments, etc.). Joyce Leung volunteered to join Dan Greenberg; more people could volunteer as well – contact Dan (dgreenbe@sfu,ca) if interested.

Two categories of logos (contest runs for both at the same time):

- Small logo: for Department official use on website, letters, etc. Idea is to have a clean, crisp design that integrates all aspects of the Department research (e.g. "molecules to ecosystems"). Prize for winner is 100\$ MEC gift card.

- Large logo: for T-shirts, coffee mugs, water bottles, etc. Also 100\$ MEC gift card for winner (50\$ contributed by the Caucus, as motioned at the last meeting).

iv. Historical ecology meeting

SFU is hosting the second annual historical ecology meeting in November 13-15, 2015. Historical ecology studies the influence of humans on landscape ecology/ecosystems (typically with long-term datasets, interdisciplinary focus). Talks on November 13 apply to large audience in Biological Sciences. Students on organizing committee are looking for minor contributions from REM, BISC, and archeology departments and grad caucuses to help run the event; the three departments and REM and archeology caucuses have committee funds.

Advance U partnership: there was an agreement to spend 5000\$ to have consultant company draft an action plan, based on the GSS mission statement, to help direct GSS business decisions in the future. Controversy was to bring in an outside group rather than hire students as usual, but motion passed.

There was also an agreement to put together a hiring committee for a GSS director, and there should be a new director by September. Application will go out soon.

Also, it was approved that the GSS should send a letter to President Petter, regarding university negotiations with TSSU.

4. TSSU (Adrienne Berchtold, Leon Li, Josh Pol, Fauve Strachan)

Reps absent to caucus meeting, but Fauve Strachan sent email to Dan Greenberg with following updates:

- Outgoing and incoming stewards should contact tssu@tssu.ca to let them know of the status of their role.

- The TSSU is distributing stickers to be placed on graded items being returned to students (some were dropped off in the BISC office printing room - more available at TSSU office).

- Quarter-sheets are being provided to explain grade withholding (again, some dropped off in the BISC office printing room with more at TSSU office and online). That means that anything due after June 19th at midnight will have their grades withheld. It is very important to show a united front and withhold grades as per the recommendations of the TSSU.
