What does poverty mean for children growing up in the 21st century? Evidence from Young Lives

Young Lives (www.younglives.org.uk) is tracking 12,000 boys and girls in Ethiopia, India (Andhra Pradesh), Peru and Vietnam, with a view to finding out about their lives and informing policies to reduce childhood poverty and inequality. The study is uncovering evidence of things children are gaining with economic development and the spread of modern ideas and services, as well as things they are losing. This presentation highlights the impacts of poverty on children growing up in the 21st century and the associated dilemmas.
