



## BC GRADE12 DIRECT ENTRY STUDENTS

### 1. Where is SFU drawing BC Grade 12 Direct Entry students from?

Based on 2007/08 data, the highest number of BC Grade 12 students entering SFU directly from high school are from the Surrey School District (SD) followed by Vancouver, Coquitlam, Burnaby, Richmond, North Vancouver, Delta, Langley, Maple Ridge-Pitt Meadows, and New Westminster in the Top 10. Students from these SDs constitute 96% to 97% of SFU's total BC Grade 12 direct entry students each year. Table 1 contains a list of the Top 20 sending SDs (see also Figure 1 of Appendix A).

### 2. What is SFU's Market Share of BC Grade 12 Direct Entry Students by SD?

In terms of percent share of these BC Grade 12 direct entry students to the total number of BC Grade 12 graduating in each SD by year, the ranking of SDs is different. While the Surrey SD sends the largest number of BC Grade 12 direct entry students to SFU, these students only constitute 15% of its total Grade 12 graduates. The largest percent share of BC Grade 12 direct entry students comes from Burnaby followed by Coquitlam, Vancouver, Surrey, Richmond, New Westminster, North Vancouver, Maple Ridge-Pitt Meadows, Delta, West Vancouver, and Langley. The market shares of the SDs that rank after the Top 10 range from 0.4% to 4.6% (see Table 2 and Figure 2 in Appendix A).

### 3. What is the SFUs Market Share by School in the Top 4 School Districts?

The market share is calculated by dividing the number of BC Grade 12 Direct Entry students admitted to SFU divided by the number of Grade 12 graduates at each school. "0.0%" may occur either where none of the school's students are attending SFU or where the number of total graduates by school and year is not available. There are however a very small number of the latter occurrences. Appendix B shows the actual number of these students admitted to SFU by school.

#### 4. What is the BC Grade 12 population projection for these Top 4 School Districts?

Based on Public School Aged Headcount Enrolment Projections produced by the Ministry of Education in 2008/09, the enrolment in these Top 4 school districts is relatively stable between 2008 and 2018. By 2018, the headcount enrolments of Burnaby and Vancouver are projected to increase by 4.2% and 1.2% respectively, while Coquitlam and Surrey are projected to decrease by 9.7% and 0.6% respectively.

Figure 1A: Burnaby Headcount Enrolment Projections

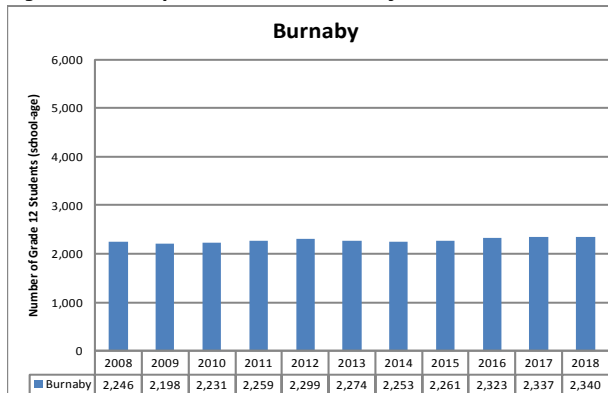


Figure 1B: Burnaby (Indexed to 2008/09)

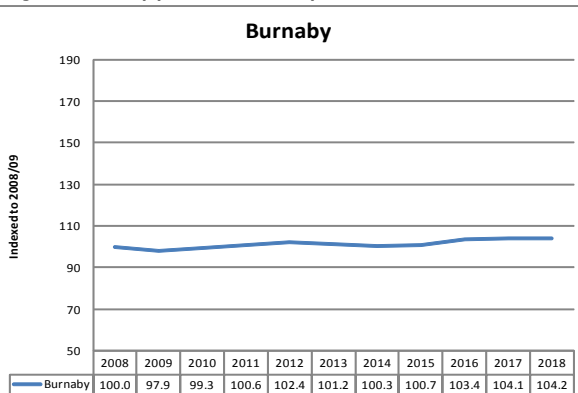


Figure 2A: Coquitlam Headcount Enrolment Projections

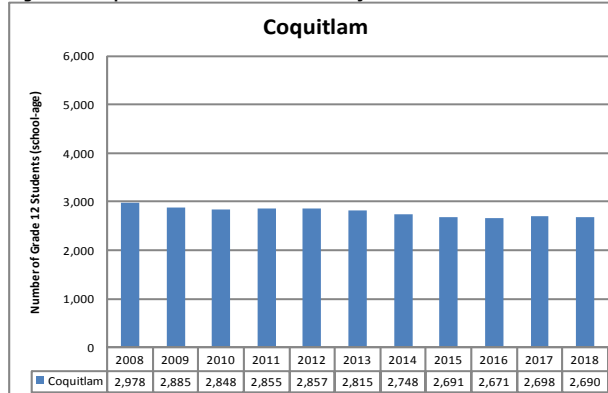


Figure 2B: Coquitlam (Indexed to 2008/09)

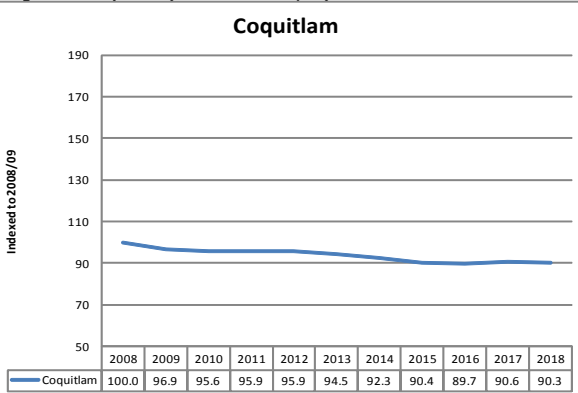


Figure 3A: Vancouver Headcount Enrolment Projections

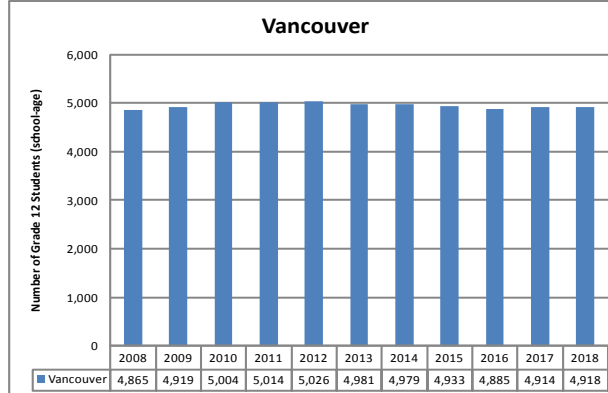


Figure 3B: Vancouver (Indexed to 2008/09)

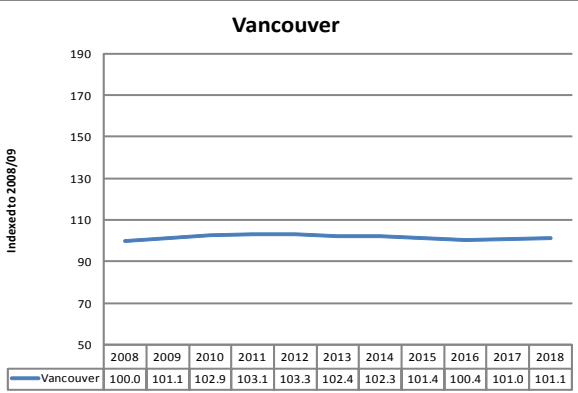


Figure 4A: Surrey Headcount Enrolment Projections

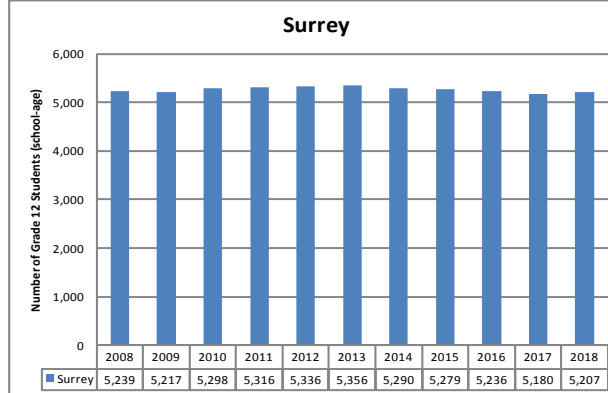
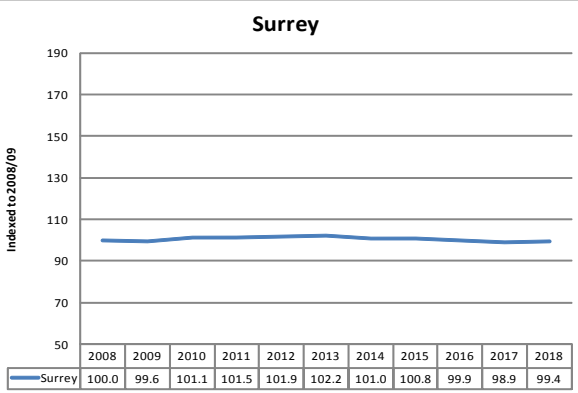
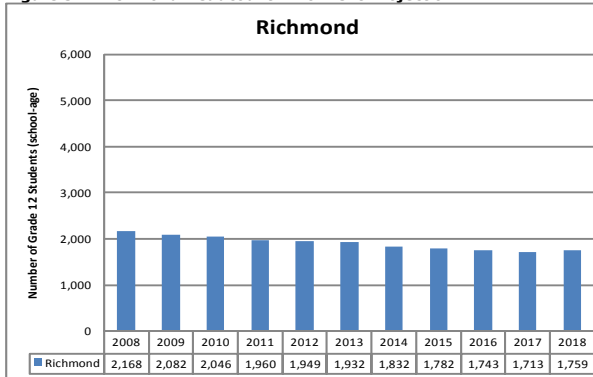


Figure 4B: Surrey (Indexed to 2008/09)

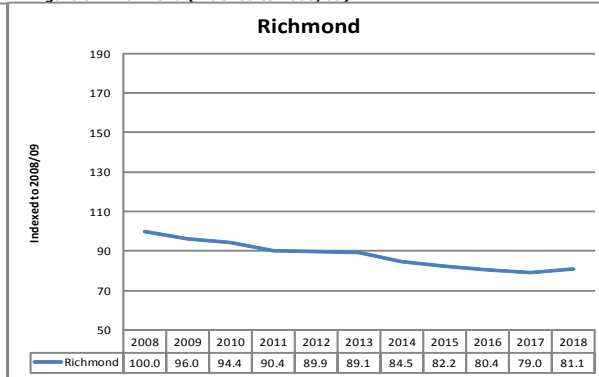

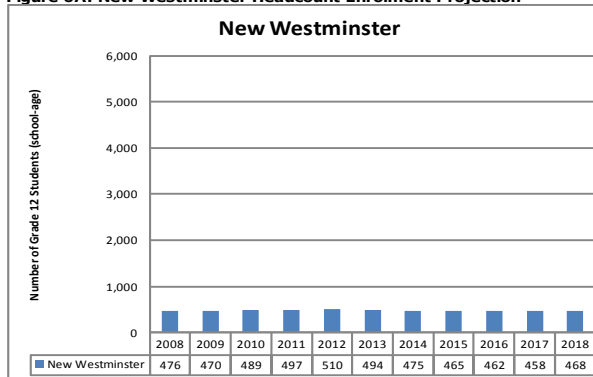
**Figure 5A: Richmond Headcount Enrolment Projection**



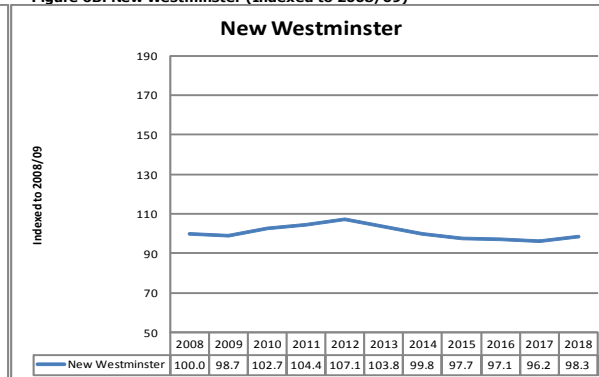
**Figure 5B: Richmond (Indexed to 2008/09)**



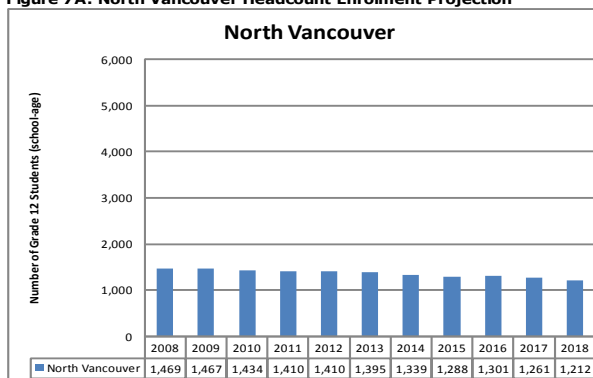
**Figure 6A: New Westminster Headcount Enrolment Projection**



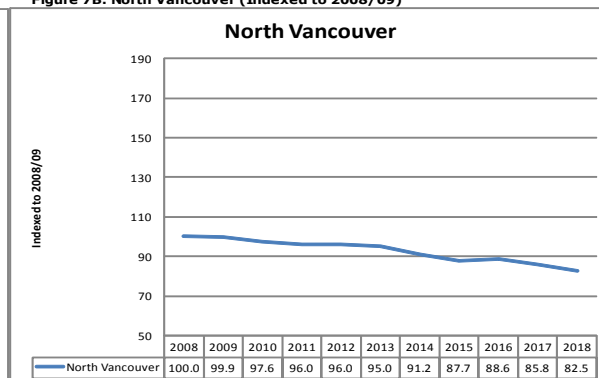
**Figure 6B: New Westminster (Indexed to 2008/09)**



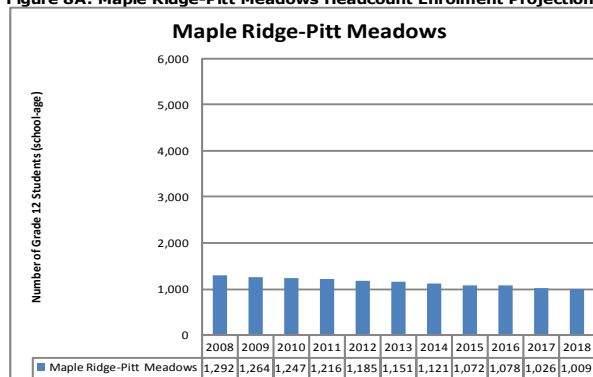
**Figure 7A: North Vancouver Headcount Enrolment Projection**

**Figure 8B: Maple Ridge-Pitt Meadows (Indexed to 2008/09)**

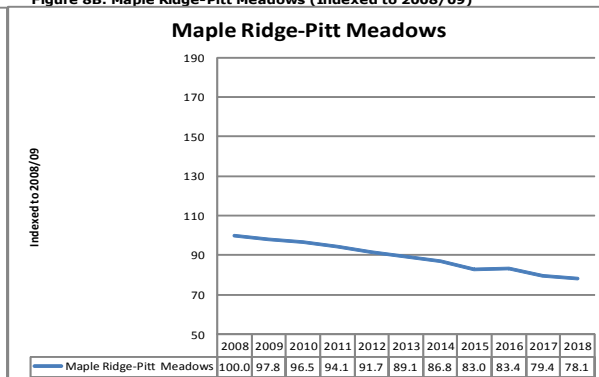


Figure 9A: Delta Headcount Enrolment

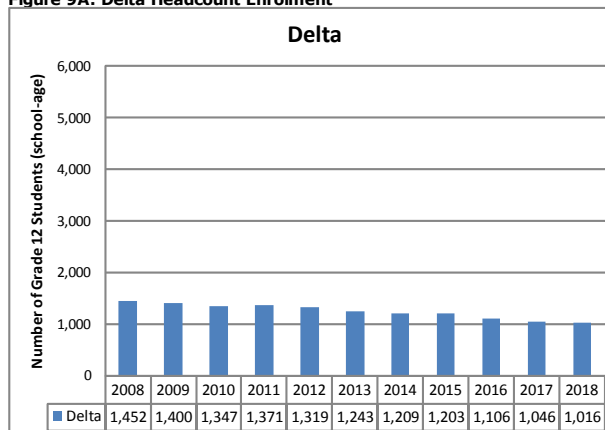


Figure 9B: Delta (Indexed to 2008/09)

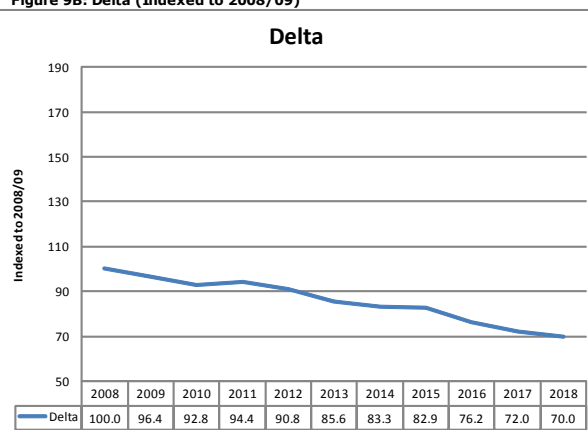


Figure 10A: West Vancouver Headcount Enrolment Projection

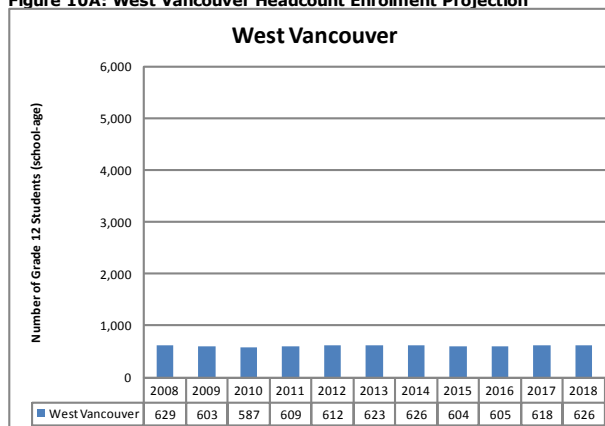
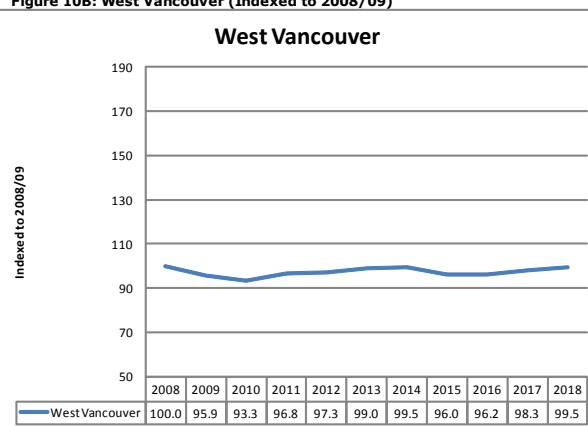


Figure 10B: West Vancouver (Indexed to 2008/09)

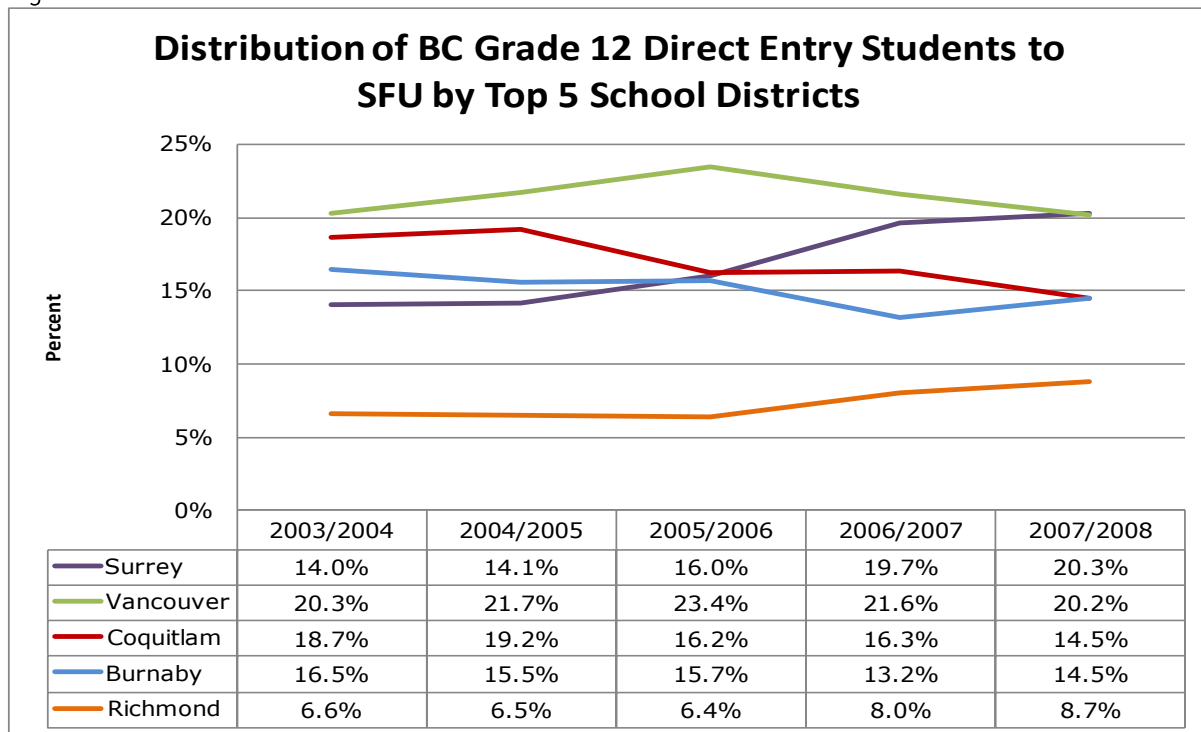
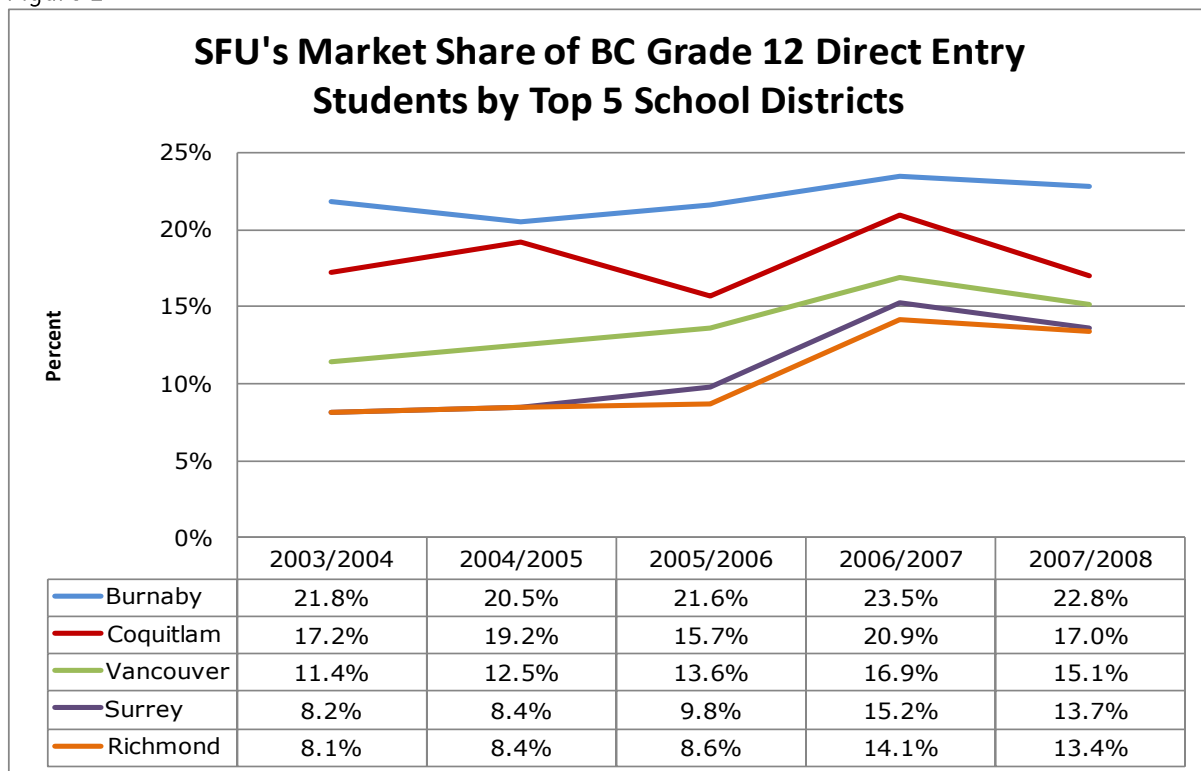
