5. Student Exchange

For the 2014 Calendar Year, International Services for Students received 453 applications to participate in the University's bilateral and multilateral exchange programs (an increase of 0.5% from 450 applications in the 2013 Calendar Year).

Of the 453 applications:

- 34% (152) were incomplete or were not approved (compared with 41% (184) in 2013).
- 66% (301 out of 453) were selected by ISS to participate (compared with 59% (266 out of 450 in 2013).

Of the 301 applications selected:

- 79% (238) resulted in completed exchange terms (compared with 79% (228 out of 266 in 2013)
- 18% (55) cancelled (compared with 14% (38) in 2013).
- 3% (8) deferred their exchange terms to 2015.

In total, 252 exchange terms were completed in 2014 (a decrease of 1 term from 253 in 2013) – 14 of which were either deferred or continued from the previous program year.

6. International Co-op Program (information from co-op)

In 2013/14, in the International Co-op Program there were 277 work practicums over 26 countries. This is an increase from previous years (171). Contributing factors for this change include program partnerships with employers in Korea, China and also through the ongoing marketing efforts in the US.


