

SFU Economics changing CGPA requirement for minor program to 2.4

Beginning in the Fall 2018 term, SFU Economics is changing its cumulative grade point average (CGPA) admission requirements for acceptance into the Economics Minor programs. Currently, the department requires a CGPA of 2.6 for admission to the Economics Minor and Extended Minor programs. Effective Fall 2018, the required CGPA is changing to 2.4.
