A. INTERNATIONAL STUDIES MINOR REQUIREMENTS¹

- 12 lower division credits
- 16 upper division credits

B. LOWER DIVISION REQUIREMENTS:

Students complete a minimum of 12 international studies lower division units, including:

- IS 101-3

C. UPPER DIVISION REQUIREMENTS:

Students complete 16 upper division units, at least 12 units must be completed from international studies course offerings at SFU.

Optional Concentrations:

Students have the **option** of taking one/a concentration to enhance their international studies minor program.

Students complete 16 units of upper division electives, 12 of which have to be in their chosen concentration. At least 12 of the 16 upper division units must be completed from international studies course offerings at SFU.
