Reflections on Institutionalizing a Transnational Cultural Studies

Provost Chair Professor, National University of Singapore

This lecture reflects on the institutionalization of the Inter-Asia Cultural Studies Project, which has a twenty-year history since it was inaugurated in early 1990s, when the rapid rise of capital in East Asia provoked simultaneously the triumphal discourse of 'East Asia difference' and its critical response within and outside the region. Professor Chua will detail the history of the project and its wide-ranging impact on the imagination and possibilities of diverse forms of intellectual integration in Asia.
