Minimum 25 credit hours Criminology, including CRIM 300, 320, 330, 333, and CRIM 432 (each with a C- or better). CRIM 369 and 462 are NOT permitted.

Minimum 20 credit hours Women's Studies, including one (1) of WS 400 or 405.

*Recommended: WS 303 Special Topics when offered as "Women and the Law".
