Criminology Major Requirements for Second Degree Students

Students must complete a minimum **60** credits which must include:

All lower division (100/200) prerequisites for admission to the School of Criminology listed above (each with a C- or better) must be completed through SFU course work, as part of their 1st degree (credit will NOT be granted, however, recognition may be given for the content of such previous work), or a combination of both.

Minimum **36** credits of upper division (300/400) Criminology plus an additional **9** credits upper division from any subject (including Criminology) for a minimum of at least **45** total credits of upper division work. The minimum 36 credits in Criminology must include CRIM 300-3, CRIM 320-3, 321-3 and CRIM 330-3 (each with a C- or better). A minimum grade point average of 2.25 must be maintained to continue in the Criminology major

Writing, Quantitative and Breadth Requirements:

One Upper Division Writing Course, and One Quantitative (Normally fulfilled by Crim 300W and Crim 320/321).
