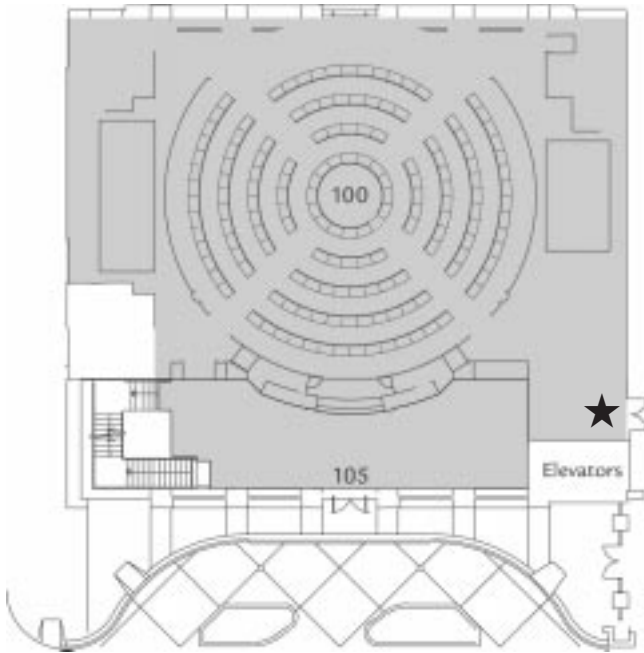

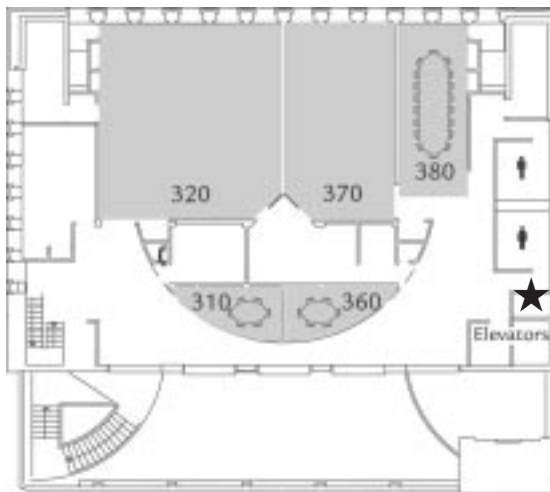
Floor Maps



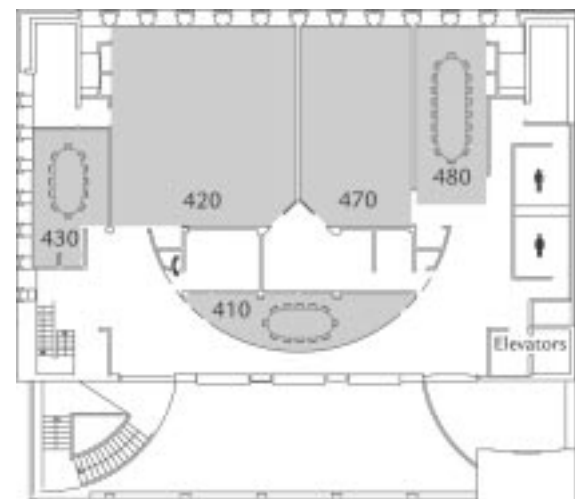
MAIN LEVEL
