Earth Sciences requires a Sessional Instructor to teach EASC 104 Geohazards – Earth in Turmoil for the Summer 2012 semester. This course will be offered at Burnaby Campus, May through August 2012. Lectures are scheduled for Monday 14:30-16:20 and Wednesday 14:30-15:20 (enrollment capacity 300).

EASC104 -- An introduction to the range of geological hazards that affect the Earth, the environment and humanity. Topics covered will include the hazards and risks related to volcanic eruptions, earthquakes, landslides and avalanches, tsunamis, geomagnetic storms and other potentially cataclysmic events. The forecasting and possible mitigation of these geohazards will also be investigated.

Qualifications: Sessional Instructors must hold a graduate degree, preferably a Ph.D.
