Preparation in Academic Skills is a 14-week program designed for low-intermediate international students who are looking forward to an academic career at SFU. Students attend 19 hours per week of classes. The program comprises two core courses: Integrated Skills (12 hours/week) and Global Issues/Canada and the World (7 hours/week). These are supplemented by three 2-hour tutorials: Grammar, Fluency, and Reading/Research. A Teaching Assistant will be assigned to each tutorial to assist students with their class work and research project.

Teaching Assistants will work under the supervision of the PAS Program coordinator and will attend weekly briefing meetings.

Teaching Assistants will be hired according to TSSU Article XIII, F 2, 3, 4; XIV, F. and the Departmental Hiring Criteria.
