Her main field research focuses on politics in daily life in reserves. She has also conducted research on religious changes in Algonquian communities (Algonquian rituals in Catholic churches, Catholic mission churches and Native Christian art and Oblate heritage). Her most recent article, co-written with Dr. Marie-Pierre Bousquet, examined the drinking culture among Algonquian peoples.
