






#### futurism

modernist movement celebrating the technological, future era; tecnological triumph of people over nature: car, plane, industrialism




deliberate departure from tradition; express feelings and ideas; acceptance of line, form, color as valid subject matter by themselves; began later in Italy as razionalismo





 1912: Fiat looked to the American way of mass production and lowering costs; produces the Fiat Zero

#### fascism

Benito Mussolini promises a return to glory production days of WWI; wins election in 1924 and fascist rule from 1926; subsidizes domestic industries in the 1930s








novecento "900" from. razionalismo but integrates Italian traditions with modernism; accepted fascist style

with more focus on industrial development, industrial design follows













the word "design"
was not yet part of
the Italian vocabulary;
"industrial design'

most products were prototypes only as technology to make them is not available





car designers adopted
the streamlined look;
in 1936, Fiat introduced for
the first time a car designed
for social reasons, not spectular
looks; the Fiat 500 was the world's
smallest car and became
ubiquitous on Italy's roads





1932-1935: Adriano Olivetti considered a pioneer of functional design through his MP 1 and Studio 42 typewriters



1940: Luigi Caccia Dominioni and Livio and Pier Giacomo Castiglioni caused a sensation with the introduction at the Milan Triennale of their Bakelite raido for Phonola, **designed** with the functional aesthetics of the telephone... a symbol of progress




