in the mid-60's he switched from fine art to design
in 1967 he left Italy for a decade to travel the world
was a founding member of Group N
interested in the idea of programmed art
was on of the most exciting figures in the Radical Design movement
anti-functional
not the best qualified to be an industrial designer

always looked up to Miles Van de Rohe as an innovator helped encourage Cesaro Cassina appreciates Frank Gehry

encourage interactions between users and the products builf products with built-in variations emphasis on differences than standardization never eager to fit the modle more interested in the meaning of his work than the function allows himself to experiment always looking for new materials
