

# illustrator workshop part 2: Banana Document Tutorial

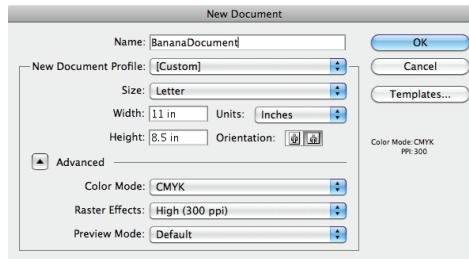
Before we get started with the tutorial we first need to create two folders on the desktop.

Create folder called 'Banana Document'  
Create folder inside Banana Logo called 'images'

Step 1) Open illustrator

Step 2) Create a new illustrator file

In the following fields enter:  
Name: BananaDocument  
Size: letter  
Orientation: LandScape  
Color Mode: CMYK



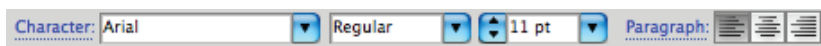
Step 3) Copy and Paste the 'Banana Logo' into your new file



Step 4) Select the 'type'  tool from the tool menu

Step 5) Click anywhere and begin typing.  
Type any Company Name

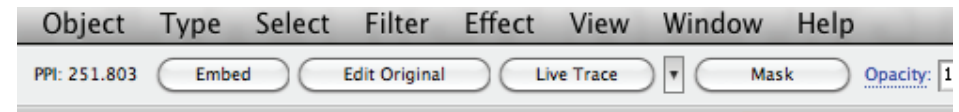
Step 6) Change Font, Size Accordingly



Step 7) Change the colours of the font

Step 8) place "bananaTree" picture

Step 9) Resize picture and click 'embed' from control menu



Step 9) Resize picture and click 'embed' from control menu

Step 10) Create a new text box CLICK and DRAG to create a text box

Fill box with text.  
Copy and paste text from text file ( file name here loremipsum.txt )

Step 11) Select company name

Step 12) Now convert The Company name  
Type > create outlines

select rectangle tool from Tools bar  
create shape over image  
select both objects  
go to Objects > Clipping Mask > Make
