My only issues with the course were that week to week, it wasn't always clear what assignments were due. Myself and a number of other students ended up sending emails to the professor a few times to resolve some issues of confusion we had. My suggestion, for a course like this where the assignments might not exactly match a syllabus, would be for the professor to send an email outlining what's expected for next class after the current class.

Dr. Hira is a refreshing page from the book of old-school. He has high expectations, works us hard, but delivers quality education at every level. I have great respect for his teaching ability and disposition. Always feel I learned something valuable from his course.
