News

- The Christmas social is currently being planned.
 - o The budget for the social is \$3000.
 - o Date
 - 58 people participated in the vote deciding the date 46 voted for Friday, December 8th
 - o Venue
 - Blarney Stone

- They have the 15th and 8th
- Their price list has been posted on slack. Their cheapest option is \$25 per person for a buffet dinner and we are required to spend \$1500 minimum.
- However, the space for trivia is limited.
- If the 8th is booked, we can reserve the upstairs area. If the 15th is booked, we can reserve the downstairs area.
- Oscars
 - They only asked us what we wanted to spend.
- Steamworks
 - This venue is expensive. We have to spend \$3000 minimum.

- There was a meeting with the library and all other societies. They gave some information about present support that the library has to offer and future plans for the library.

 - There is a new online library system updated in May. The library is looking for feedback on this system. As well, they are trying to update their system so that it takes fewer clicks to get to papers.
 - The library is looking for feedback on the workshops led by the research commons.

 - The library wants to remind students that uploading published articles to shared websites is copyright infringement.
