Translink based study on 145, projecting 25,000 riders each day. Expecting UniverCity to rise from 55k to 90k residents in the coming years. Environmental concerns (more carbon emission efficient than busses but no other info). Level of detail in nearly all answers was not adequate. There will likely be a vote shortly with regards to whether or not the GSS supports the project.

- Space working group about the opening of the new student union building can also be joined by anyone who is interested.
- New international student working group as well. Aims to bring awareness to issues affecting international students as well as bridge the gap between any existing services.
