Division and allotment will be determined by popular vote, except if stipend levels are to remain unchanged.
  - ii. Stipends will be paid at the conclusion of each semester
  - iii. Turnover: Stipends will be paid at the end of the semester. For the outgoing caucus, stipends will not be paid for the Fall semester stipends paid at the end of fall will go to the incoming caucus. No stipends are to be paid to the caucus members whose duties are concluding today. The new stipend policy will take effect from Nov 7<sup>th</sup> onward.
