

GRACE WOODSWORTH MACINNIS GRADUATE AWARD

Terms of Reference

This award was established in honour of Grace Woodsworth MacInnis in recognition of her outstanding contribution as a Canadian parliamentarian and a pioneer woman in Canadian politics.

1. The purpose of this award is to provide financial support to a student entering the graduate program in Women's Studies at Simon Fraser University.
2. The Grace Woodsworth MacInnis Graduate Scholarship is a one-semester award the value of which is based on the interest accrued to the endowed fund. The award value is approximately \$2000. When sufficient funds are available, the award is renewable for a further two semesters provided a satisfactory academic record is maintained.
3. The criteria for this award are:
 - a) demonstrated scholarly promise
 - b) engagement on behalf of women on campus and/or the wider community
 - c) financial need.
4. This award may be held in conjunction with other awards made by Simon Fraser University or other agencies where permitted by those agencies.
5. Application is made on the **Application for a Private Graduate Scholarship** form and must be accompanied by:
 - a) copies of all postsecondary transcripts
 - b) one letter of reference from a faculty member familiar with the applicant's work
 - c) a concise statement of financial need.
6. The completed application and all supporting documentation must be received by the department of enrolment by **March 15**.
7. The award will be made by the Dean of Graduate Studies, on behalf of the Senate Graduate Awards Adjudication Committee.
