-- FORMATION OF GROUPS FOR IN-PERSON CLASSES

Groups of four (possibly five) will be formed using a random procedure usually in the second class of the term. Students not attending the second class will be assigned to a group with available space. Sector selection for each group will be done usually in the third class of the term based on the order in which groups will present.

-- FORMATION OF GROUPS FOR ONLINE CLASSES

Groups will be formed by each student submitting by email to <u>poitras7@sfu.ca</u> a list of 4 preferences for the presentation sector. Groups of four (possibly five) will be formed based on placing individuals into the group with highest preference.

- -- Preferences will be processed in the order received at the email address. If a group you selected first is already full when processed or there are not enough with preference for that sector, a second choice will be considered, etc. It is not necessary to do the stocks listed in each sector, one or more new ones can be used.
