

Rules for Three Stock Game

- 1) Select Three Publicly Traded Stocks

Example: IBM, CP, SU

The following information about these stocks is required:

- a) The ticker symbol
- b) The exchange the stock is traded on
- c) The current price (in the local currency)

→ this information can be provided by printing the information page from one of the websites listed on the class webpage

THE SELECTIONS ARE SUBMITTED BY THE SECOND LECTURE
(nothing more is required until the end of term).

- 2) Restrictions on Selections

- a) **NO INDEX PRODUCTS OR ETF's (Prof takes indexes)**
- b) No derivative products – including warrants
- c) No stocks with prices less than \$5

Possible Strategies

- a) Winners (Losers?) Lists
- b) BNN Market Call selections
- c) Sector plunging
