NATURAL GAS is the most common fuel source for heating and water systems in BC homes.



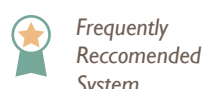
In BC, most **ELECTRICITY IS PRODUCED FROM HYDROELECTRIC POWER**, a renewable resource.

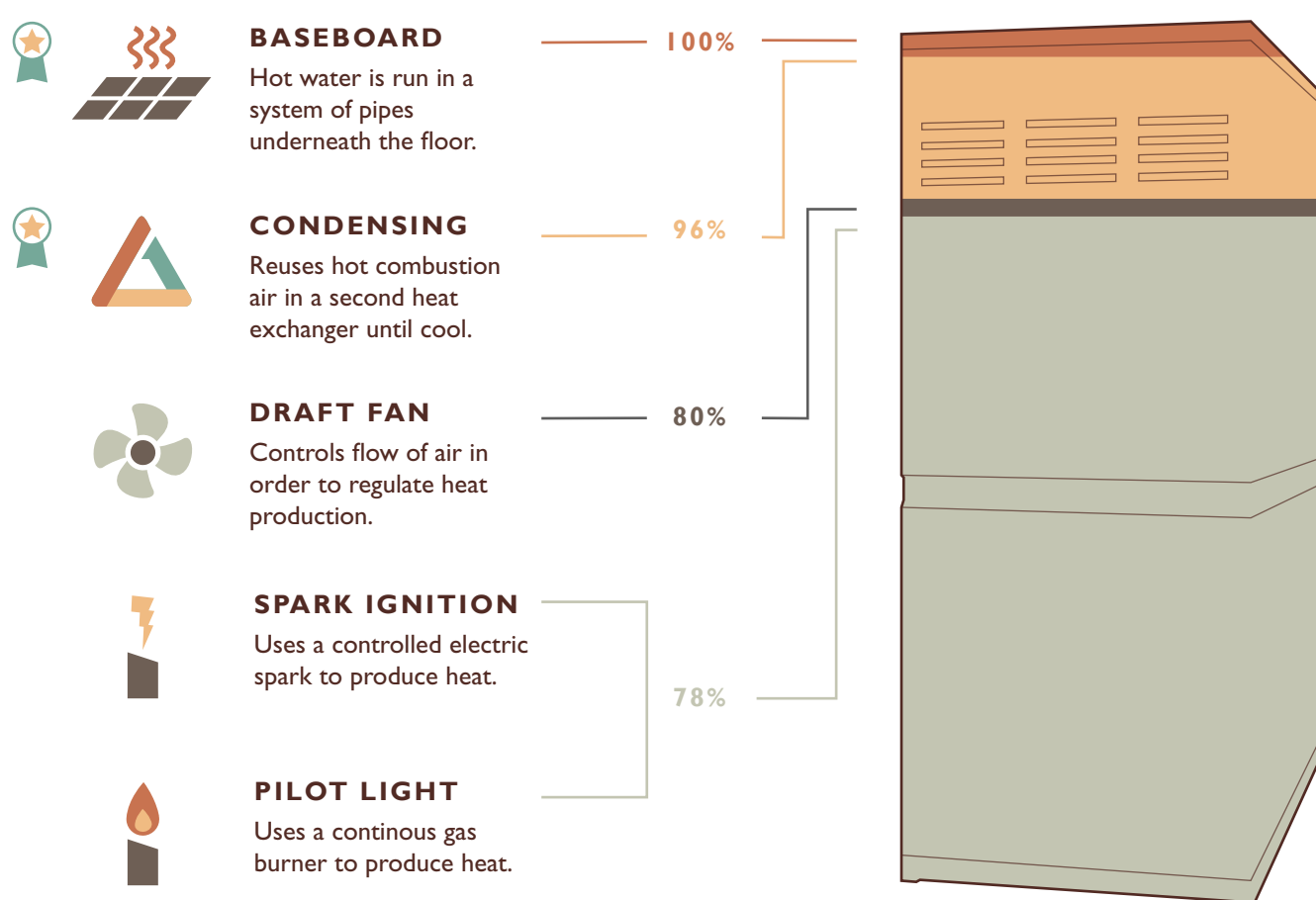

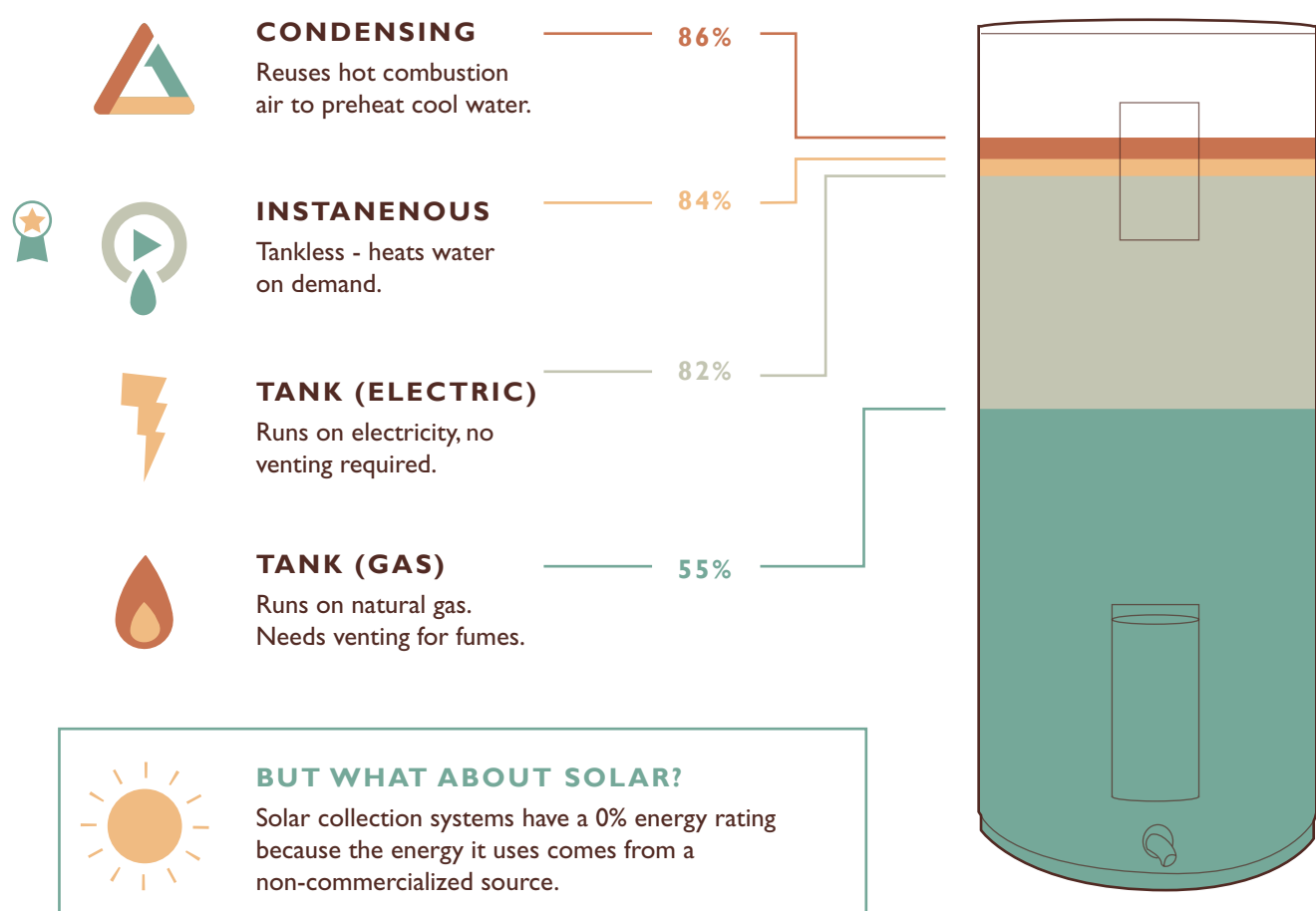

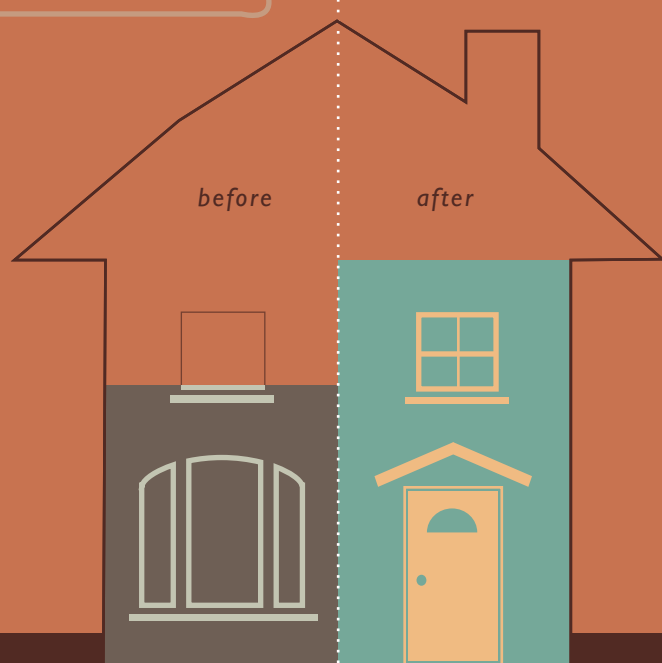

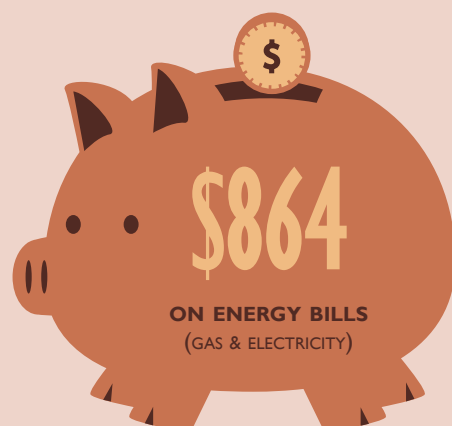
