Following a discussion of proposed calendar entries with other department heads in the Faculty of Arts I wish to propose the following additions to the submitted programme in Geography.

The following is a recommended sequence of lower division course work for students with regular entry:

Semester 1: Geography 101-3.

Semester 2: Geography 161-3 or 162-3.

Semester 3 and 4: Geography 211-3, Geography 221-3, Geography 241-3.

Students with regular entry are advised not to take more than one course in Geography in each of their first two semesters. Students proposing to major in Geography or to take honours will profit greatly if they select a wide range of outside subjects during their first four semesters; Economics, Anthropology and Sociology, History, and all subjects in the Science Faculty can be of great value to the prospective geographer. A student may wish to take a "minor" in one of these fields, and any faculty members in the Department of Geography will be happy to advise.
