1. Availability of Faculty Council Minutes

3. Special Education Project

The Senate endorsed the recommendation from the Faculty of Education for a Special Education project as follows:

"that the Faculty of Education endorse the proposal of the Department of Behavioral Science Foundations to establish off-campus a Centre for Handicapped Children. The purposes of this Centre would be three-fold:

1. The training of new teachers within the Professional Development Program.
2. The provision of education for children not normally accommodated by school districts.
3. The re-training of existing teachers."

4. Special Emphasis in Elementary School Physical Education in the Professional Development Program

Senate received a report from the Faculty of Education regarding a project for providing special emphasis in elementary school physical education to students in the Professional Development Program.
