JUSTIFICATION

New Courses - Econ. 496 and Comm. 494

At the present time, there are no courses whereby special interests of faculty and students can be accommodated. As staffing considerations permit, the Department would like to offer work which does not fit within the courses presently offered. A selected topics course will permit a degree of flexibility which we feel is essential.
