Subject REQUIREMENTS TO CONTINUE IN
GRADUATE STUDIES.

Date AUGUST 21, 1969

The Senate Committee on Graduate Studies, on July 21, 1969, following submission of recommendations by The Executive Committee of that body, passed the following motions, and requests that Senate approve these motions as policy, effective commencing the results of the Fall Semester 69-3.

1. "That the Senate Committee on Graduate Studies recommend to Senate that for a student to receive a graduate degree from the University he must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher over all courses taken for the degree."
2. "That the point values outlined on Paper GS-71 be adopted and recommended to Senate for approval:- A 4 points, B 3 points, P 2 points, F 0 points."
3. "That in the absence of specific approval to the contrary by the Senate Committee on Graduate Studies that a student be required to maintain a 3.0 cumulative grade point average to continue in a graduate program."

NOTE: It is understood that previous records need not necessarily be amended to show point values but may be so amended for continuing students.
