INCREASED SENATE MEMBERSHIP

In the belief that the interests of the University as a whole will be better served than at present, I give notice of motions as follows:

Motion 1.

That Senate, under the provisions of Section 23 (i) of the Universities Act, increase the number of members by one, to provide for membership of the person duly elected President of the Student Society of Simon Fraser University, whosoever he/she may be from time to time.

Note: If motion 1 passes, one further member will be required under Section 23 (j) to be elected by the Faculties either in joint meeting or in such manner as the Faculties in joint meeting may by regulation determines.

If Motion 1 passes, the following motion will be made:

Motion 2.

That should the person duly elected President of the Student Society of Simon Fraser University resign from that office or otherwise cease to hold that office, such resignation or cessation shall immediately constitute termination of his membership on Senate, with his successor in office, when duly elected, to assume the vacant membership.
