Attached are the transfer lists for B. C. Grade 13, and the public Regional Colleges (Capilano, Malaspina, Okanagan, Selkirk and Vancouver City College). The transfer list for the College of New Caledonia, which opened in September, 1969, will be submitted at a later date, as course descriptions were not received until recently.

The lists cover the 1966-67 to 1969-70 academic years, and so can be used for students applying for credit on the basis of retroactive or current use of Ellis Report policies. There are a limited number of courses which are being offered for the first time in 1969-70 on which recommendations have not yet been made, generally due to a shortage of information on the courses. Recommendations on these courses will be made at a later date.

In all cases, the "Semester Hour Equivalent" shown on the lists is a direct conversion of the credits awarded by the College to the Simon Fraser unit.

The "Type of Credit" is designated on the lists by the numbers 1, 2, 3. These represent:
