Subject SENATE ELECTIONS

Date JULY 20, 1970

The Senate Nominating Committee has submitted its nominations for a number of elections to be held by Senate at its meeting of Monday, August 3, 1970.

Under Senate regulations any Senator who wishes to add nominations to any of those listed below may do so by notifying the Secretary of Senate in writing of such nominations, to reach his office no later than Friday, July 31, 1970. Nominations received after that time, and nominations from the floor, cannot be accepted.

If a nomination is made, the Senator making the nomination must ensure in advance that the nominee is willing to stand for election.
