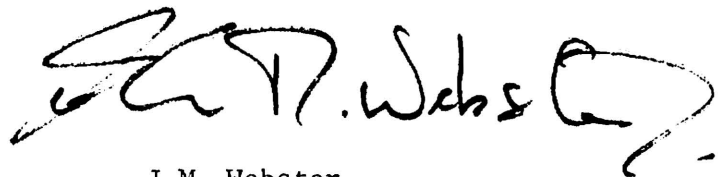

Type: Standing

- Purpose:
- a. To ensure that the standards approved by the Senate are maintained
 - b. To consider matters of policy related to graduate studies and to make appropriate recommendations to Senate
 - c. To consider matters referred to it by Departments and Faculties or by the Dean of Graduate Studies and to make recommendations to the appropriate body(ies).

Terms of Reference of the Executive Committee of the Senate Graduate Studies Committee shall be as follows:

Purpose:

- a. To consider matters of policy related to graduate studies and to make recommendations to the Senate Graduate Studies Committee
- b. To interpret Senate's policy on admission and other matters pertaining to graduate studies
- c. To consider all matters referred to it by the Dean of Graduate Studies and to make recommendations to the appropriate body(ies)
