The Academic Board was constituted under the former Universities' Act, but there is not continuation of this body under the new act which became effective July 1974. In view of this no steps were taken to elect a new member to the Board this year.

The attached letter from the Secretary of that Board indicates a desire for continued membership to December 31, 1974 or shortly thereafter.

In view of the brief remaining period it seems unnecessary to call for nominations from the nominating committee and formal vote by Senate but this shall be done if Senate so instructs.

It is recommended that the term of B. Wilson be extended to December 31, 1974 or shortly thereafter if required.
