Subject SENATE ELECTIONS

Date SEPTEMBER 23, 1975

MOTION 2: "That ballot elections now be held to elect one Faculty of Interdisciplinary Studies Senator to the Senate Committee on Honorary Degrees (SCHD); one Student Senator to the Senate Committee on Honorary Degrees (SCHD); two Senators at large to the Senate Library Committee (SLC); one alternate Student Senator to the Senate Library Committee (SLC); Four Senators at large and one Student Senator and one Student Senator Alternate to the Senate Nominating Committee (SNC); one Lay member Senator to the Senate Committee on Continuing Studies (SCCS); one Student Senator and one Student Senator Alternate to the Senate Committee on Continuing Studies (SCCS); four Faculty members, one from each Faculty, to the Senate Committee on Scholarships, Awards and Bursaries (SCSAB); two Lay member Senators to the Senate Committee on Scholarships, Awards and Bursaries (SCSAB); two Student Senators and one Student Senator alternate to the Senate Undergraduate Admissions Board (SUAB); and one Senator Lay member to the Senate Committee on Undergraduate Studies (SCUS)."

Note: If additional nominations to those appearing in the attached paper are received by the deadline of Friday, October 3, 1975, a new motion will be circulated at the meeting of Senate to accommodate such nominations and for ballot elections where necessary.

The Chairman of the Senate Nominating Committee, on behalf of the Senate Nominating Committee, has submitted nominations for a number of elections to be conducted by Senate at its meeting of October 6, 1975.
