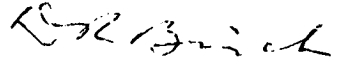

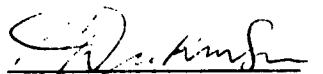

Subject Change in requirements for a major

The change approved by S.C.U.S. at its last meeting was requested by the Kinesiology Dept. for the following reasons:

- (1) The current calendar description is ambiguous. Students have misinterpreted the phrase "any one of: Kin. 420-3" to mean that they must complete one of those courses rather than that they may complete only one of those courses.
- (2) In examining the wording because of problem (1) the department felt that some allowance must be made for students who wish to take more than one of these courses. It was felt particularly that the Kinesiology Special Topics courses should be available to majors for credit towards their degrees. This is partly a reflection of a change in attitude towards Special Topics courses. Rather than single presentations of topics occurring because of faculty commitments they have frequently been used to try "in the field" courses which are later made a part of regular offerings. To deny a student credit towards a degree for taking such a course was not felt to be equitable by the department.

CHANGE IN REQUIREMENTS FOR MAJORS IN KINESIOLOGY (UPPER DIVISION)

Current Calendar Entry:

During the last four levels (semesters), students must advance their total of accumulated hours to at least 120, of which 45 must be numbered 300 or above and which include the following specific courses (12 hours):

Kin. 326-3	Functional Anatomy
Kin. 405-3	Human Physiology I
Kin. 406-3	Human Physiology II
Kin. 407-3	Human Physiology Laboratory

and 30 hours from any of the following:

Kin. 303-3; 320-3; 330-3; 336-3; 366-3; 401-4;
402-4; 442-3; 450-5; 466-3; 480-3; 496-3;
498-3.

Any one of:

Kin 420-3; 421-3 or 422-3; FPA. 324-3 and 326-3;
Phys. 333-4.

Proposed Entry:

Students must advance their total of accumulated hours to at least 120, of which 45 must be numbered 300 or above and which include the following specific courses (12 hours), normally taken during the last four levels:

Kin. 326-3	Functional Anatomy
Kin. 405-3	Human Physiology I
Kin. 406-3	Human Physiology II
Kin. 407-3	Human Physiology Laboratory

and 30 hours from any of the following:

Kin. 303-3; 320-3; 330-3; 336-3; 366-3; 401-4;
402-4; 442-3; 450-5; 466-3; 480-3; 496-3; 498-3; and

including not more than 9 hours from the following -

Kin 420-3; 421-3; 422-3; FPA 324-3; 326-3; Phys. 333-4.
