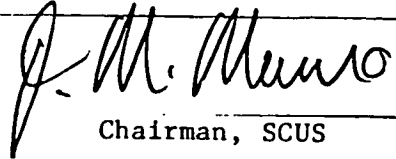

RATIONALE:

Effective Fall 1979, BUEC 231-3 (formerly ECON 231-3) is no longer the sole pre-requisite for BUEC 332-3 (formerly ECON 332-3). The projected enrollments for BUEC 231-3 are now such that the course will not be offered frequently enough to serve students planning to include ECON 331-5 in their program.
