CHANGE IN PREREQUISITE

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FREN 303-3 French for the Classroom

Study of the various aspects and problems of French as a second language.

(Lecture/Tutorial)

FROM: Prerequisite: French 206 or equivalent

TO: Prerequisite: French 301 and French 306 or equivalent (or permission of the Course Chairman)

Rationale:

French 301: the language prerequisite has been raised by one course to create more homogeneity among students taking French 303. The large majority take this course in their last semester of studies before entering P.D.P. and therefore already have taken French 301. The few students with only F. 206 cannot keep up with the rest of the class.

French 306: this French linguistics prerequisite has been added because basic concepts, theories and methods must be known before their application to the teaching of French as a second language can be taught.
