Old title: ARCH 875-5 Seminar in Fossil Man

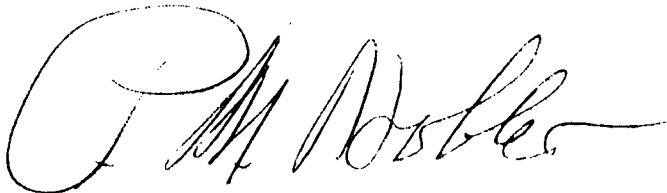
New title: ARCH 875-5 SEMINAR IN PALEOANTHROPOLOGY
