Subject: Committee vacancies on Senate Committees

Vacancies currently exist on the Senate Committees noted below and elections to these committees will be conducted by Senate at its meeting of January 10, 2000.

Under Senate regulations, any Senator who wishes to submit nominations may do so by notifying the Secretary of Senate in writing of such nominations. Nominations must be received by the Secretary of Senate no later than 4:30 pm, Friday, January 7, 2000.

Nominations received after that time will not be accepted. Senators making nominations must ensure in advance that the nominee is willing to stand for election.

Committee to Review University Admissions (CRUA)

One Graduate Student (at-large) to replace Nadeane Trowse as the Alternate member from date of election to May 31, 2000.

Senate Committee on International Activities (SCIA)

One Graduate Student (at-large) to replace Kevin Hewitt from date of election to May 31, 2000.
