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>After discussion with the Computing Science Executive Committee, we have
>decided to suspend admissions to the Computing Science PBD programme
>indefinitely. We believe that the ARC programme better serves this group
>of students. One of the major advantages of the ARC programme is that
>students are guaranteed space in the courses that they need. In contrast,
>the PBD students have such low registration priority that the courses are
>full before they have a chance to register.

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>We request that the Registrar's Office not admit any more students to the
>Computing Science PBD programme until further notice.
