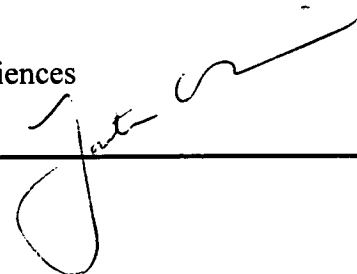

Latin American Studies Program

- Program description and degree requirements
- Course changes – credit hours, descriptions
 - LAS 800-5 to 800-4 Approaches to Research in Latin American Studies
 - LAS 815-5 to 815-4 Theories of Latin American Development
 - LAS 825-5 to 824-4 Latin American History and Culture
 - LAS 835-5 to 835-4 Social and Political Change in Latin America
 - LAS 851-5 to 851-4 Directed Readings in Latin American Studies

Rationale:

Program description and courses were re-defined subsequent to an external review – these changes would bring the M.A. in LAS program in line with other graduate programs in Arts & Social Sciences.

At its 8th January 2007 meeting, Senate Graduate Studies Committee approved the following curriculum and calendar changes in the Faculty of Arts & Social Sciences:

Philosophy (GS2007.03)

Program description changes for the calendar - application procedures, degree requirements for the M.A. and Ph.D. programs - these were noted as housekeeping items.

English - M.A. program (GS2007.04)

Master of Arts for Teachers of English (MATE)
A new stream to the M.A. program for Surrey campus - designed as a refresher course for school teachers to teach English literature with current critical approach. Calendar changes to the program description, admission requirements and some housekeeping items were included.

Economics - minor course changes (GS2007.05)
