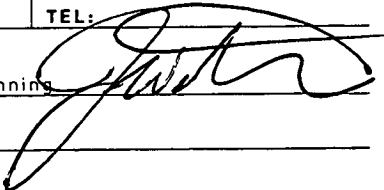

SIMON FRASER UNIVERSITY UNDERGRADUATE ENROLLMENT PLAN

This document contains an enrollment plan for

undergraduate program majors by Faculty and site from 2007/08 to 2014/15. This enrollment plan will be reviewed and adjusted annually as the planning environment and strategic priorities change. Actual historical enrollments for 2001/02 to 2006/07 are also provided for information. This undergraduate enrollment plan is a subset of the university enrollment plan for graduate and undergraduate students.

Pages 3 and 4 provide a plan for program FTE's (or student majors). The PgmFTE plan begins with the ministry FTE funding, followed by the total undergraduate enrollment; the total is further separated into domestic (funded) FTE's and international (unfunded) FTE's on page 4. The domestic FTE's in table 5p correspond to the "official" FTE's reported to the Ministry of Advanced Education at the end of the 7th week of the semester and these should ultimately match the FTE funding in table 1p.

Pages 5 and 6 provide activity FTE's (or course enrollment FTE's delivered by each Faculty, by site). These activity FTE's or AFE's correspond to the "internal" enrollment reports of course FTE's distributed to all programs, departments, schools and Faculties by the Office of Analytical Studies at the end of the third week of each semester.

This enrollment plan is an update to the undergraduate enrollment plan approved by Senate last year (February, 2006). Over the last several months, a number of changes have been applied to last year's plan to develop this latest plan. These changes were applied to adjust for actual enrollment performance in 2006/07 and anticipated changes in demand. The changes and assumptions in this enrollment plan are provided below:

- 1) As a result of the recently announced graduate expansion plan, 56 undergraduate FTE's were deducted from the undergraduate 2007/08 FTE target and added to the graduate 2007/08 FTE target. This swap occurred entirely in Health Sciences.

- 2) The undergraduate Health Sciences enrollment plan remains relatively unchanged from the February 2006 Senate approved enrollment plan.

- 3) Due to actual 2006/07 enrollment performance, 100 FTE's were deducted from planned FTE's in Applied Sciences and this was offset with a corresponding increase of 100 FTE's in Business Administration.

- 4) The enrollment plan for Business Administration was further adjusted in years 2007/08 thru 2009/10, such that Business program FTE's remain at 2006/07 levels throughout the period. This revision allows Business to remain at their current levels, rather than taking an enrollment reduction after attaining higher than expected enrollment levels in 2006/07. To accommodate the increase to Business, program FTE's in Applied Sciences and Arts & Social Sciences were each reduced by 37.5, 67.5 and 12.5 FTE's in 2007/08 thru 2009/10.

- 5) To adjust for the softening demand for international students, as evidenced by the shortfall in international students in 2006/07, the international enrollment target for 2007/08 has been revised to 9% of funded undergraduate enrollments (a reduction from the initial plan for 10%). Planned international enrollments will resume to 10% of domestic enrollments, starting in 2009/10. Planned undergraduate international enrollments are distributed across faculties in similar proportions to 2006/07.

- 6) Prior to the recent swap of 56 FTE between undergraduate and graduate FTE's, SFU transferred 163, 297 and 1159 undergraduate program FTE's from the ministry targets in 2006/07, 2007/08 and 2009/10 to the graduate FTE targets. This is still reflected in the AVED funding in table 1p.

- 7) Increased program FTE's to Education by 48 FTE's to accommodate a PDP cohort. This was offset by a reduction of 48 FTE's in Applied Sciences.

Simon Fraser University: Visual Undergraduate Enrollment Plan (PgmFTE's)

This document provides a visual overview of the SFU undergraduate enrollment trends and enrollment plan. Domestic (funded) and international (full cost recovery) enrollments are each provided separately. Each chart focuses on three time ranges, with each range providing slightly different information:

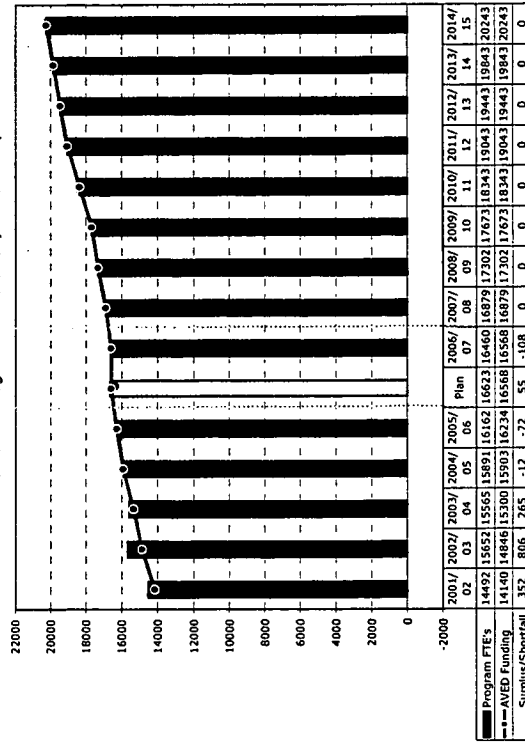
- 1) 2001/02 through 2005/06 provides actual enrollments.
- 2) 2006/07 shows planned enrollments (yellow) vs. actual enrollment (red).
- 3) 2007/08 through 2014/15 shows planned enrollments.

A separate pair of charts for each faculty is provided on the following pages, with domestic enrollment trends on the left side of the page and international enrollments on the right. In each of these displays, the bar charts indicate the enrollment volume; the line chart represents the faculty's % share of the total university undergraduate enrollment.

These are EWK7 program FTE's. Domestic program FTE's are reported to AVED for funding purposes.

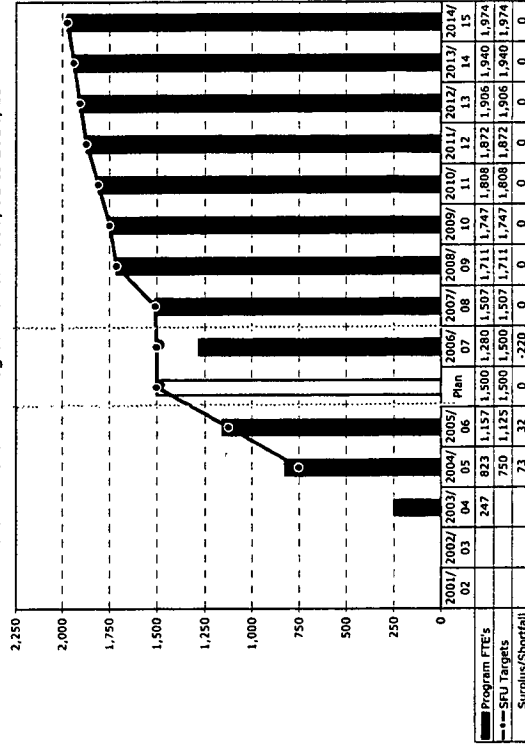

UG Domestic Program FTE's: 2001/02 to 2014/15

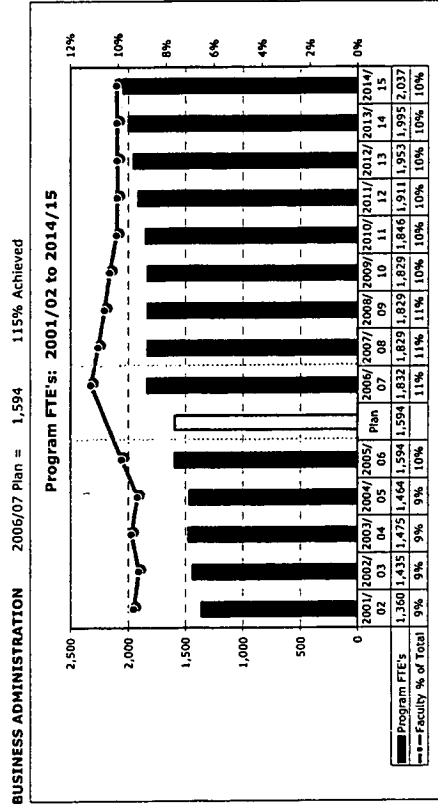
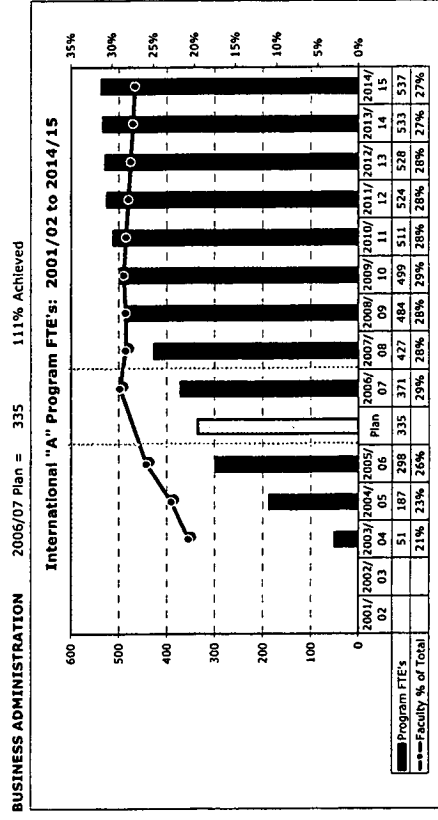
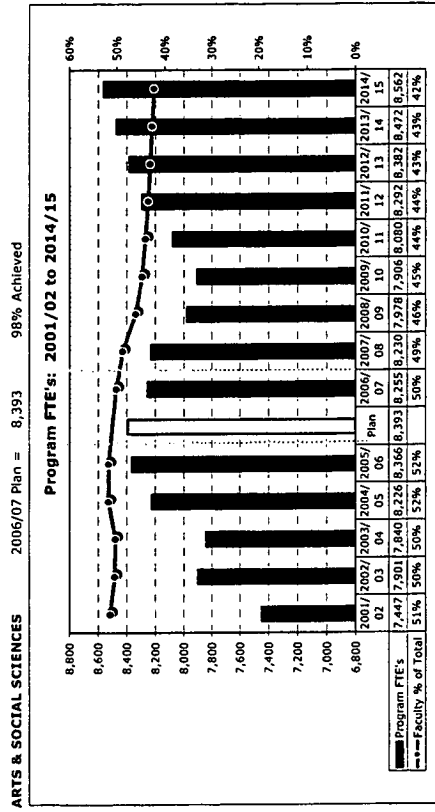
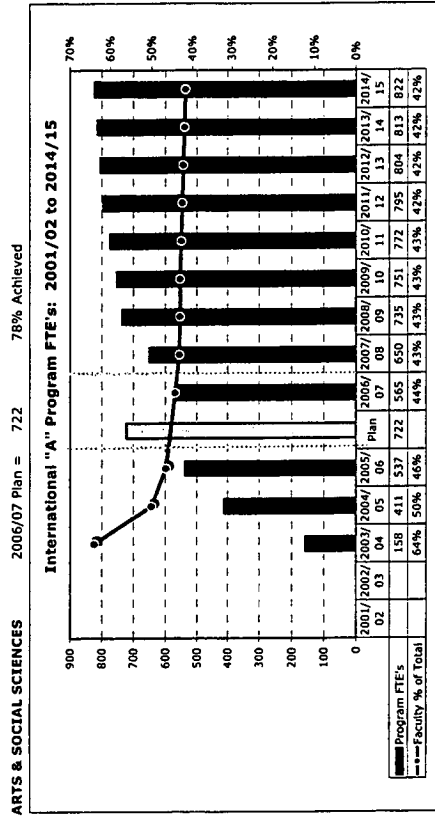
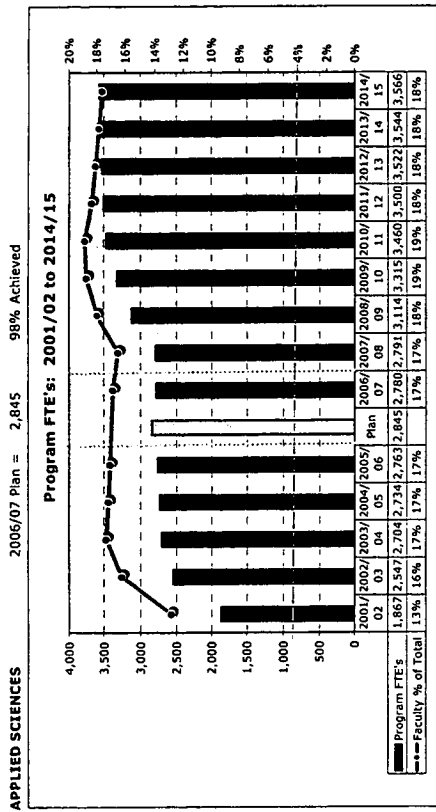
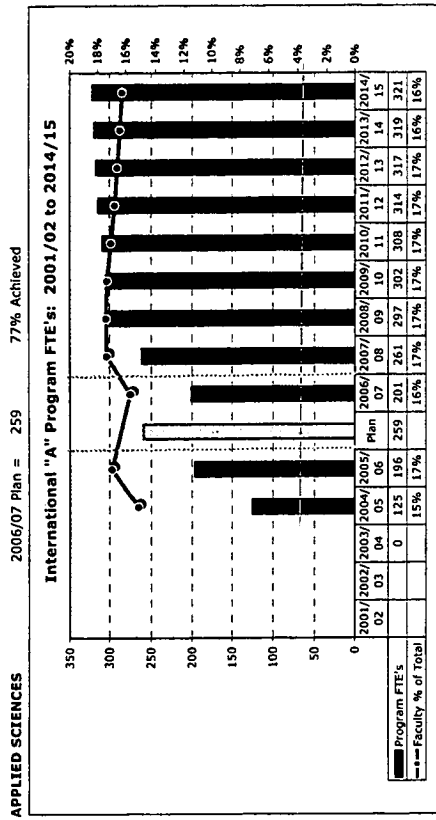

SFU Undergraduate Program FTE Enrollment: Actual and Planned

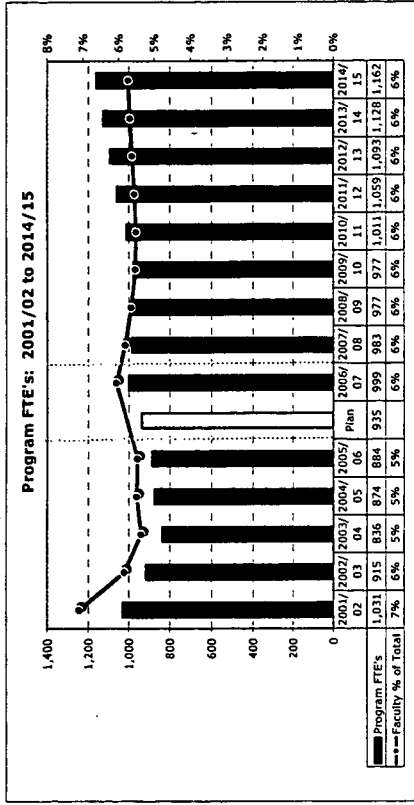

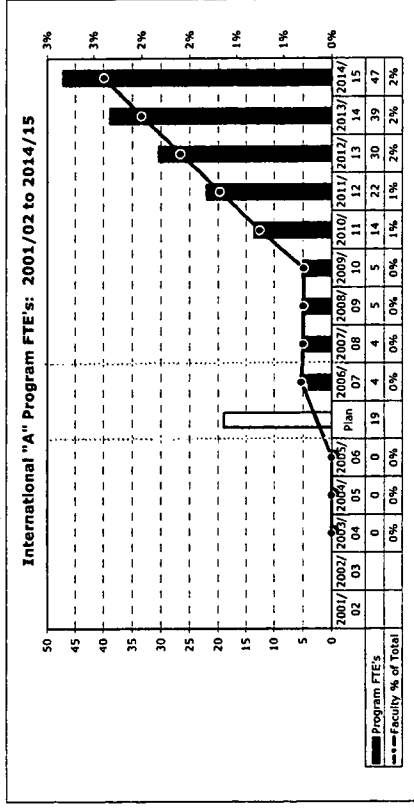

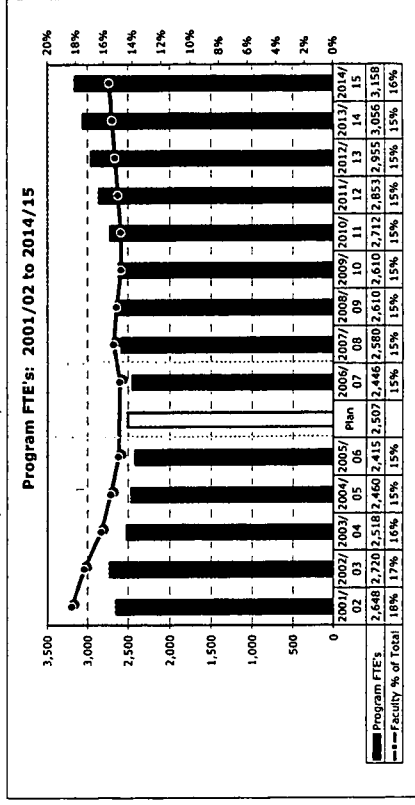
