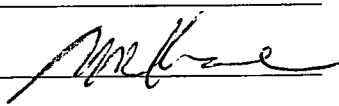

Acting under delegated authority at its meeting of February 5, 2009, SCUS approved the following curriculum revisions:

1. School of Kinesiology

- (i) New prerequisites for KIN majors in the Active Health and Ergonomics concentrations: MBB 222 and CHEM 282 (SCUS 09-01d).

2. Dual Degree Credential (SCUS 09-10)

- (i) The calendar changes to clarify the program requirements for the dual degree.

3. School of Computing Science (SCUS 09-11)

- (i) Prerequisite change to CMPT 165, 170, 307, 322W, 361, 370, 384, 474, 475 and 477 and description change to CMPT 305.

4. School of Engineering Science (SCUS 09-06)

- (i) Prerequisite change to ENSC 303, 40-403 and the deletion of credit totals from the University calendar.
(ii) The removal of ENSC 378 from the Biomedical curriculum.
