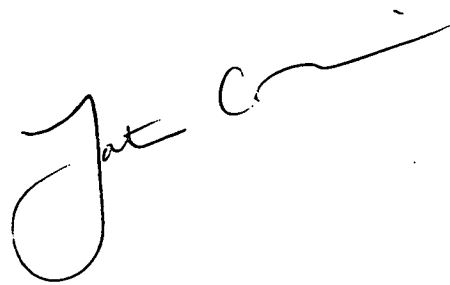

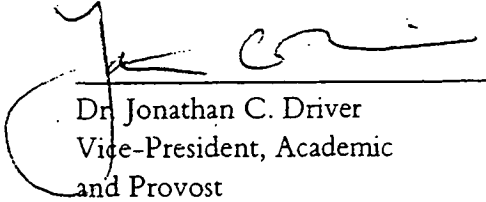
RE B. C. Synchrotron Institute - Schedule A
