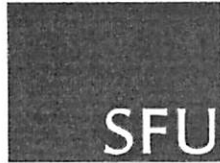
HSCI 449-3 "Community and Health Service" requires a prerequisite change to add the statement "Students may be required to successfully complete a Criminal Record Check."
