Faculty Election to Senate

A call for nominations was sent to all faculty members on May 11, 2012 for faculty positions on Senate. The following candidate was elected by and from the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences, by acclamation, to replace Shuyu Kong from September 1, 2012 to May 31, 2013:

Faculty Election to the Board of Governors

A call for nominations was sent to all faculty members on May 11, 2012 for one faculty position on the Board of Governors. The following candidate was elected by and from faculty members jointly, through an online vote, to replace Gordon Myers from September 1, 2012 to May 31, 2015:

A faculty call will be issued in the Fall 2012 term for the remaining two vacancies on Senate.

Student Election to Senate

A call for nominations was sent on May 11, 2012 to all undergraduate and graduate students for three student positions on Senate. According to the election rules, the positions were required to be filled by at least one student (graduate or undergraduate) elected from the Faculty of Applied Sciences and one graduate student. The term of office for all three positions was from June 1, 2012 to May 31, 2013.
